Subject

Inclusion of certain equipment types in the electrical energy consumption testing of refrigerated display cabinets

Ruling:

For non-integral equipment (eg signage that may be hung from the refrigerated display cabinet but does not draw its power from the refrigerated display cabinet), the unit shall be tested without such equipment. For integral equipment (such as integrated signage) that draws its power from the refrigerated display cabinet, the unit shall be tested with the equipment, irrespective of the equipment having been supplied with the unit or delivered separately. If more than one variant of the equipment can be used with the refrigerated display cabinet, the unit shall be tested with the variant that consumes the maximum electrical energy over the test period.

Proposed revisions to the Standard

Add the above paragraph to the end of clause 4.2 in part 9 of the standard and alter the heading to read "Lighting and other equipment".

Add the above paragraph to the end of clause 4.1 in part 12 of the standard.
