Interpretation of Clause 1.2 d

Ruling:

That torque motors being defined as a high slip motor designed primarily to provide torque, often at or near 100% slip be exempted from the requirements of this standard under the provisions of Clause 1.2(d).

This exemption is based upon the fact that constraints placed on the design requirements for torque motors would in practical terms exclude them from compliance with MEPS.
